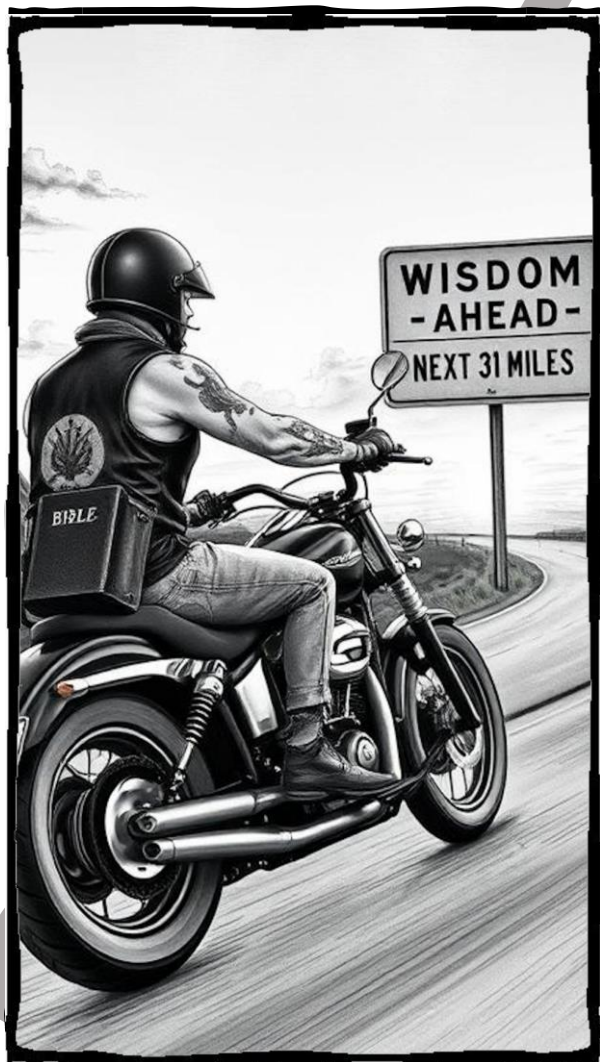

**PROLOGUE: BACKGROUND
CHECK: SOLOMON AKA SHLOMO**

Every true brother on the road earns a name that sticks, something deeper than just a nickname. For this king, the patch read Shlomo, his road name. It wasn't random either. That name comes from the Hebrew root שָׁלוֹם (shalom), meaning peace, wholeness, and rest. His old man, King David, gave it to him with a mission in mind. David said, "His name shall be Solomon (Shlomo), and I will give peace and quiet to Israel in his days." And sure enough, during Shlomo's reign, Israel saw more peace than a desert highway at sunrise.

Shlomo didn't grow up in the streets, he was royal born, son of the mighty David, the warrior-poet who slayed giants and wrote psalms with a heart chasing after God. But unlike his father who ruled with the sword, Shlomo ruled with wisdom, sharp as a custom blade. When he had the chance to ask the Lord for anything, he didn't ask for more chrome or...

Proverbs Wisdom Mile Chapter 1

• Wisdom's shout hits the streets. This is a wake-up call to stop playing with fire and start riding straight.

1 Solomon, son of the legendary rider David and King of the whole scene, laid down these street-truths for anyone tough enough to listen.

2-4 • Built to Train You How to Ride Right

2 This book's here to teach you how to ride right, live clean, and handle yourself with street smarts. 3 It'll tune you up with good judgment, solid decisions, and doing what's straight, not shady. 4 It's got fuel for newbies and grit for young bucks trying to wise up.

5-6 • Listen and Level Up

5 Even seasoned riders can learn more if they lean in. 6 These words'll help you crack them codes, read between the lines, and understand the deep talk of the wise.

7 • Where It All Starts

7 Respect for the Big Man upstairs, that's the first step to real knowledge. Fools? They laugh at wisdom and ride straight into major wrecks...

8-9 • Listen to Your Folks

8 Son, don't blow off what your dad teaches, and don't shrug off your momma's advice. 9 What they give you will shine on you like a custom chain or a patch earned the hard way.

10-19 • Don't Ride with Wrong Pack

10 If punks try to pull you into their crew, don't bite. 11 If they say, "Let's mug someone for excitement, hurt them bad and watch them bleed," 12 like they're swallowing souls whole, 13 "We'll score big loot and pack our saddlebags with it," 14 and they say, "Roll with us, we'll split it all," 15 don't go near their road. 16 They race toward chaos, packs of them speeding toward sin. 17 A bird's not dumb enough to fall for a trap it sees, 18 but these fools set up their own destruction, ambushing themselves. 19 That's the ride you're on if greed's your road captain.

20-33 • Wisdom's Warning Shot

20 Wisdom's yelling out in the streets, her voice echoing down alleys. 21 She's calling from the busiest corners, shouting truth at the top of her lungs. 22 "How long you gonna act like clueless punks? You jokers love being dumb and..."

Proverbs Wisdom Mile Chapter 2

• Chasing real wisdom is like hunting down treasure. It'll guard your ride and keep you from wiping out.

1-5 • Hunt for Wisdom Like It's Gold

1 My son, if you soak up my words and stash my commands like gear you never leave behind, 2 if you tune your ears to wisdom and lean in hard to understand it, 3 if you cry out for insight, yell for clarity, 4 if you chase it like cash and dig for it like buried treasure, 5 then you'll get what it means to fear the Lord and find real knowledge from God above.

6-11 • Wisdom Will Guard Your Ride

6 The Lord's the one who gives wisdom, straight from His mouth come the real goods: knowledge and understanding. 7 He stocks up sound wisdom for those riding clean and true. 8 He's got your back if you walk the straight road, guarding the path of those who belong to Him. 9 Then you'll get what's right, what's fair, & how to handle every twist in the road. 10 When wisdom gets in your head & truth lights up your heart...

Proverbs Wisdom Mile Chapter 6

• Don't Be Stupid, Stay Sharp. If you're gonna ride with wisdom, you better steer clear of bad deals, lazy living, and shady folks. This chapter lays down some hard truth about staying outta trouble and living straight.

1-5 • Don't Sign Stupid Deals

1 If you shook hands on a bad loan for someone else, 2 or opened your big mouth and backed a fool with your name, 3 then boy, you better get outta that fast. Humble yourself, go find that guy, and beg to be released. 4 Don't sleep on it, don't wait till morning. 5 Break free like a deer from a trap, or a biker dodging a roadblock.

6-11 • Don't Be Lazy, Son

6 Take a ride out and watch the ants, boy. They don't have a boss barking orders, 7 no foreman or manager riding 'em, 8 but they stack their supplies all summer and gear up for the winter grind. 9 How long you gonna lay there, son? You just gonna snooze your life away? 10 A little nap here, a little folding of the hands there...

Proverbs Wisdom Mile Chapter 27

• Ride Smart Today, Don't Count on Tomorrow's Road. Brothers sharpen each other like steel on steel. A lone wolf gets soft and sloppy, ride with the right crew. True friendship is rare as a perfect ride, so treasure it when you find it.

1-6 • Don't Brag About Miles You Ain't Ridden

1 Don't go flappin' your jaws about your big plans for tomorrow, the road might have different ideas than you do. 2 Let other riders praise your skills, not your own mouth, that's just cheap noise. 3 Rocks are heavy and sand's a burden, but dealin' with a fool's rage is heavier than haulin' both. 4 Anger cuts deep, but jealousy? That's a whole different animal, meaner than a junkyard dog with a tooth ache. 5 Better to get a straight-up call-out from a brother than to miss the warning signs because someone's afraid to speak up. 6 Wounds from a true friend come from a place of ...

1. Tell Folks You're Ridin' With Jesus

Don't keep quiet about what just happened. Let your family, your crew, and anyone else know you're ridin' with Christ now. Your confession matters.

Romans 10:9 (BVB)

If you speak it out loud that Jesus is Lord, and believe deep down He rose from the grave, you're in. Saved and riding with the King.

2. Get Baptized and Make It Public

Baptism is like putting on your new patch. It's a bold move that shows you belong to Jesus. It doesn't save you, but it's how you go public with your faith.

Acts 2:38 (BVB)

Peter stood up and said, "Turn from your sins, get dunked in Jesus' name, and you'll be forgiven and fueled up with the Holy Spirit."

3. Find a Solid Church Crew

Don't ride alone. Join up with a real-deal church that teaches the Word straight and lives it loud. That's your support and accountability.

Hebrews 10:25 (BVB)

Don't ditch the gatherings like some

folks do. Stick with the crew. Push each other to ride harder and hold the line.

4. Read the Word Every Day

The Bible is your map, your weapon, and your tune-up guide. Start reading daily. Proverbs, John, and James are great places to start.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 (BVB)

Every verse in God's book is straight from Him. Good for teaching, fixing what's busted, correcting your ride, and training you to roll right.

5. Pray Like You're Talking to the Good Leader

Prayer isn't just church talk. It's real connection with your Father. Talk to Him often, about everything, and keep it honest.

Philippians 4:6 (BVB)

Don't stress about a thing. Bring everything to God, your needs, your thanks, your fears. Lay it all out in prayer.

6. Leave Sin in the Dust

Repentance means turning your bike

around and leaving your old life behind.
You're a new rider now, so live like it.

2 Corinthians 5:17 (BVB)

When you join up with Christ, the old you dies. A new rider is born. Fresh build, clean start.

7. Help Others Find the Road

Now that you've been changed, don't keep it to yourself. Share the truth. Live bold. Love strong. Show others where to find the Way.

Matthew 28:19-20 (BVB)

Roll out and make disciples. Baptize them. Teach them to ride with everything I taught you. I'm with you all the way.
